New Employee?



We have developed a helpful form to sign-on a new employee: the **Payroll Authorization form**.

Employees are required to have available RRSP room in order to contribute to SPP. The contribution amount can be changed at any time — SPP is flexible and voluntary.

It is important for you and your employees to review this arrangement on an annual basis.
