PLATINUM JUBILEE MEDAL

T4A AND GENERAL INFORMATION

We have mailed the 2022 T4A slips to anyone who received a payment during the year. This slip reports any taxable benefit and tax withheld and is required when you file your income tax return with Canada Revenue Agency (CRA). To access a copy digitally, please log in to your account on MySPP.

- SPP income is taxable to the person named on the T4A.
- · Pension payments can be received wherever you live. Tax is withheld using the tax rates provided by CRA. Contact SPP for details.

2023 PAYMENT DATES

VB payments will be deposited into your account by the 20th day of each month.

To change your payment schedule the request must be received in our office by the 10th of the month prior to the requested payment month. The payment schedule change form is available on our website or by calling our office.

CRA requires a minimum withdrawal from your VB account every year starting the year you turn 72. Any of the required minimum not withdrawn in the year will be deposited into your account in
